Executive Summary

During the period from April 23 to September 23, Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) achieved remarkable milestones in its mission to empower youth and uplift communities. Notable highlights include:

- A successful 11-lecture series on Pharma 4.0, bridging the academia-industry gap and impacting over 220 students.
- Cybersecurity speaker sessions attended by 35 students and professionals, enhancing digital security awareness.



- Donation of 7 desktops valued at Rs. 1,40,000 to Etasha Society NGO, enabling digital literacy for 240 youth.
- E-waste awareness drives reaching 500 individuals and collecting 20 kgs of E-waste.
- Plantation of 425+ trees, benefiting over 77,000 lives, covered by media and Yugdhara magazine.
- Free distribution of ornamental & medicinal plants touching 75 lives.



- Sponsorship of welding equipment for a refugee family, setting an example for skill acquisition.
- Regular ration donations to a blind hostel, supporting 40 lives each time.



- Providing financial assistance to Nuh Riot victims and road accident victims.
- Organizing 3 community kitchens, serving food to over 7500 people.

- Hosting cultural and religious programs, reaching around 3360 community members.
- Organizing & conducting Design Thinking Hands-on Bootcamp for CS/IT teachers of ITL Public School, Dwarka.



These accomplishments exemplify SAS Foundation's commitment to its focus areas of education, health, environment, and community development. The foundation looks forward to continuing its impactful work in the upcoming months.

History and Background

Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) was founded on September 9, 2022, with a clear mission: to empower the youth to achieve Swavalamban (self-reliance) and live life with Swabhimaan (dignity). Since its inception, SAS Foundation has been committed to driving positive change in the lives of individuals and communities. Notable recent achievements include community development initiatives and support to underprivileged and persons with disabilities (PWD) communities.



Objectives and Focus Areas

The core objectives of SAS Foundation revolve around empowering the youth across a comprehensive list of 54 objectives outlined in our charter. The NGO's primary focus is on four key areas:

1. **Education:** Enabling access to quality education and bridging the gap between academia and industry, as evidenced by the successful Pharma 4.0 lecture series.
2. **Health:** Promoting health and safety, exemplified by cybersecurity sessions and assistance to road accident victims.
3. **Environment:** Advocating for a sustainable environment through E-waste awareness drives and extensive tree plantation campaigns.
4. **Community Development:** Uplifting communities through initiatives like community kitchens, cultural programs, and support to underprivileged and PWD communities.

SAS Foundation is guided by core values that emphasize genuine commitment, operational transparency, and active community involvement in all our initiatives. These values form the foundation of our impactful work and our dedication to empowering youth and fostering Swavalamban and Swabhimaan.

Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) is governed by a dedicated board of trustees who play pivotal roles in driving the organization's mission of promoting self-reliance and dignity among beneficiaries. The composition of the board evolved during the reporting period with the addition of Ms. Jyotsana Sinha and the resignation of Shri Kumar Rajan. These dedicated individuals collectively steer SAS Foundation towards its mission of empowerment and community development.

Education

1. In the field of education, SAS Foundation conducted an impactful 11-lecture series on Pharma 4.0 at DPSRU. This initiative has successfully bridged the gap between academia and industry, with an average attendance of 20 students across various diploma, bachelor, and master courses in each lecture.
2. Furthering our commitment to education, SAS Foundation organized cybersecurity speaker sessions that were attended by 35 students and working professionals.
3. As part of our dedication to empowering youth, SAS Foundation donated 7 desktops worth Rs. 1,40,000 to Etasha Society NGO. These desktops will play a crucial role in a vocational training program, imparting digital literacy to approximately 240 youth over the next five years.



4. SAS Foundation organized and conducted a Design Thinking Hands-on Bootcamp for CS/IT teachers of ITL Public School, promoting innovative teaching methodologies.

Environment

1. In line with our environmental focus, SAS Foundation conducted E-waste awareness and collection drives, touching the lives of nearly 50 individuals and collecting approximately 20 kgs of E-waste.
2. An ambitious tree plantation drive saw the planting of 425+ plants and trees in Delhi and Ghaziabad. This endeavour reached more than 77,000 lives and garnered media coverage, including a feature in The News Express and an article in Yugdhara magazine.



3. To promote a sustainable environment at the grassroots level, SAS Foundation initiated the free distribution and sale of ornamental and medicinal plants, benefiting 75 lives to date.

Community Development

1. In a significant step toward community development, SAS Foundation sponsored welding equipment worth Rs. 30,000 for a Hindu Refugee family. This act of support enabled the family to establish their own work, serving as a role model for others to acquire skills and start their own businesses. Currently, five lives have been positively impacted.



2. As part of our commitment to inclusivity, SAS Foundation made regular ration donations worth Rs. 15,290 to a blind hostel, touching the lives of 40 residents on each occasion.
3. SAS Foundation organized three community kitchens (bhandara), two in July and one in August. These community kitchens served food worth Rs. 50,230 each time, reaching more than 2500 people on each occasion. In total, over 7500 lives were touched upon through this heartwarming initiative.



4. Further strengthening community bonds, SAS Foundation hosted cultural and religious programs, including Bhagwat Katha, Chhabeel on Ganga Dusshera, Janmashtami celebrations, and more. These events collectively touched the lives of around 3360 community members.

4. E-waste awareness and collection drives have not only touched the lives of nearly 500 individuals but also contributed to the responsible disposal of 20 kgs of E-waste, safeguarding the environment.
5. The extensive plantation of 425+ plants and trees in Delhi and Ghaziabad has had a profound impact, touching the lives of more than 77,000 people. This endeavour received media recognition, with coverage in The News Express and a feature in Yugdhara magazine.
6. The free distribution and sale of ornamental and medicinal plants have enriched the lives of 75 individuals, promoting green living and wellness.



7. Sponsoring welding equipment worth Rs. 30,000 for a Hindu Refugee family has not only facilitated their self-employment but has also set an inspiring example for the community. Currently, five lives have been transformed, with the potential for many more to follow suit.

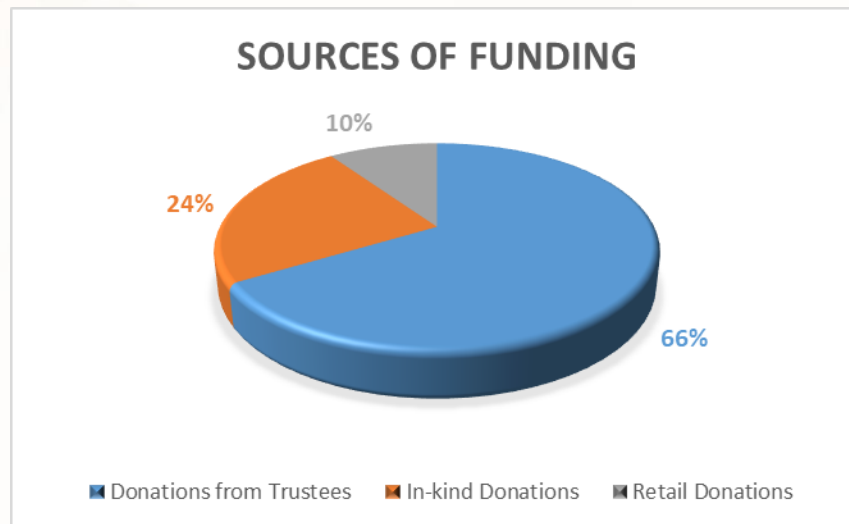
Sources of Funding

Expenditure Breakdown

In terms of expenditures, the foundation allocated Rs. 3,41,463.60 towards NGO activities. The majority of these funds, Rs. 3,36,400.96, were utilized for various initiatives undertaken during this period, reflecting a significant impact on the community. Additionally, Rs. 3,670.00 was allocated for marketing the NGO, and Rs. 1,392.64 was dedicated to regular operational charges.
