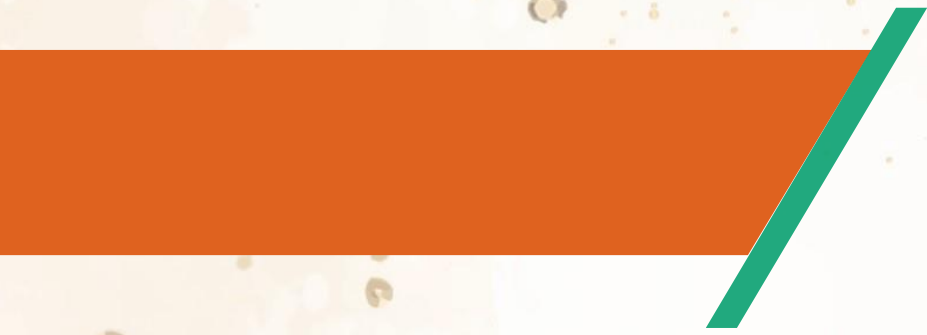

Executive Summary

From April to September 2024, the SAS Foundation made remarkable strides in its commitment to empowering communities, protecting the environment, and fostering education and cultural awareness. During this period, we successfully implemented numerous initiatives that positively impacted over 6,000 lives across Delhi, Faridabad, Gurgaon, and Mumbai. Our efforts ranged from e-waste collection drives and computer literacy donations to community welfare programs and cultural events.

Key accomplishments during this period include:

- Donation of groceries and ration to the Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center, touching 80 lives through two separate donations.
- Successful organization of multiple e-waste collection drives in partnership with Attero Recycling Pvt Ltd, resulting in the recycling of over 728 kgs of electronic waste across 12 residential communities, impacting more than 700 lives.
- Contribution of 15 computer systems and 15 laptops, with a combined worth of ₹6,00,000.00, to Government schools and ETASHA Society, benefiting thousands of students through computer literacy programs.
- Renovation of a local temple and organization of several cultural and religious events, including the Akhand Shree Ram Charit Manas Path, which engaged the youth and fostered a sense of community spirit.

- Collaboration with JV Edtech Medovation to host several informative webinars on crucial health topics, including hypertension, brain disorders, Alzheimer's, and women's safety, reaching an audience of over 300 individuals.
- Execution of Green Champions and IT internship programs, promoting environmental awareness and digital literacy among students of BGP International Public School.

Through these efforts, SAS Foundation continued to expand its reach, promoting environmental sustainability, education, health, and community development. As we look ahead, we remain committed to scaling up our initiatives and further empowering communities for a brighter future.

History and Background

The Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) was established on 9th September 2022, with a strong commitment to empower youth to achieve Swavalamban (self-reliance) and live with Swabhimaan (self-respect). The foundation aims to provide support and opportunities to underprivileged communities and persons with disabilities (PWD), enabling them to improve their quality of life and contribute positively to society.

Since its inception, SAS Foundation has focused on uplifting marginalized sections of society through community development, environmental conservation, and educational initiatives. The foundation has earned recognition for its work in creating lasting change, including organizing e-waste collection drives, donating desktops, and conducting community service events.



Objectives and Focus Areas

The SAS Foundation operates with the mission of empowering youth across four key focus areas:

1. **Education** – Providing value-integrated learning opportunities, reducing education deficits, and enhancing corporate grooming.

2. **Health** – Raising awareness on health issues and ensuring access to healthcare for vulnerable communities.
3. **Environment** – Promoting environmental sustainability through e-waste management, tree plantation drives, and other green initiatives.
4. **Community Development** – Engaging communities in inclusive initiatives for economic and social betterment.

The foundation follows a set of core values:

- **Doing real work with heart** to ensure tangible impacts.
- **Maintaining transparency** in operations to build trust.
- **Involving the community** in all initiatives for shared responsibility and participation.

Vision

To be a movement that acts as a catalyst in enabling and empowering youth towards employment and self-employment, reducing education deficits, and promoting corporate grooming in India.

Mission

- To bridge the gap for youth with no or limited access to corporate grooming and guidance towards employment and self-employment.

- To create a value-integrated learning environment that fosters strong entrepreneurial foundations and helps youth identify their potential.

Key Milestones (Before April 2024)

1. Establishment of SAS Foundation (9-Sep-2022)

- Founded to empower youth with the values of self-reliance and self-respect, focusing on the areas of education, health, environment, and community development.

2. Launch of E-Waste Collection Drives (March 2023 onwards)

- Initiated a series of **e-waste collection drives**, promoting environmental sustainability across Delhi NCR and other regions. These drives have significantly contributed to safe e-waste disposal and community awareness.

3. Desktops Donation (June 2023)

- Donated **7 desktops** to ETASHA Society to support the establishment of a youth training center, marking an important step towards advancing digital literacy among the underprivileged.

4. Community Service Events (Makar Sankranti 2024)

- Distributed food packs worth **Rs. 8284** to members of the EWS community, including house helps, sweepers, and cobblers, showcasing a strong commitment to community welfare.

5. Recognition and Awards (2023)

- **Yugdhara Global Achiever's Award 2023:** Awarded to **Nitin Saini** for his environmental initiatives and community contributions.
- **Nature's Grace Achiever's Award 2023:** Presented to **Jyotsana Sinha**, Joint Secretary, for her educational and community-building efforts.

6. Educational and Awareness Initiatives

- Organized **Pharma 4.0 Lecture Series** at DPSRU and cybersecurity sessions in collaboration with CRAC Learning to bridge the gap between academia and industry, benefiting youth and professionals.

7. Collaborations and Partnerships

- Signed an MoU with **Attero** for joint **e-waste collection and recycling**.

- Collaborated with **ITL Public School** for tree plantation drives, fostering environmental awareness among students.
- Collaborated with **CRAC Learning** and **IEEE WIE** to conduct cybersecurity lectures at **MSIT**, impacting 154 students and professionals.

8. Support for Vulnerable Communities

- Regular **ration distribution** and renovation activities at **Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center** benefitting visually impaired individuals.
- **Clothes donation drives** in Dwarka societies, distributing over **1500+ pieces of clothing** to 750 beneficiaries, including underprivileged families and Hindu refugees from Pakistan.

9. Cultural and Religious Contributions

- Celebrated **Ram Mandir inauguration** in Palam, distributing **50 kg of laddoos** to the community.
- Organized an **Akhand Ramayan Path** at Shiv Mandir, Palam, with the participation of over 350 community members.

10. Tree Plantation and Environmental Campaigns

- Led environmental conservation efforts through the **Amrit Udyan Pledge** and multiple **tree plantation drives**, including in **Loni** in collaboration with local ward councillors.
- Conducted an **e-waste collection drive in Noida** and visited an e-waste recycling facility in Manesar, Haryana.

11. Skill Development at Refugee Camp (Majnu Ka Tila)

- Supported **entrepreneurship and skills training** for refugees, empowering them to become economically self-sufficient through sustainable business ventures.

12. Internship Programs

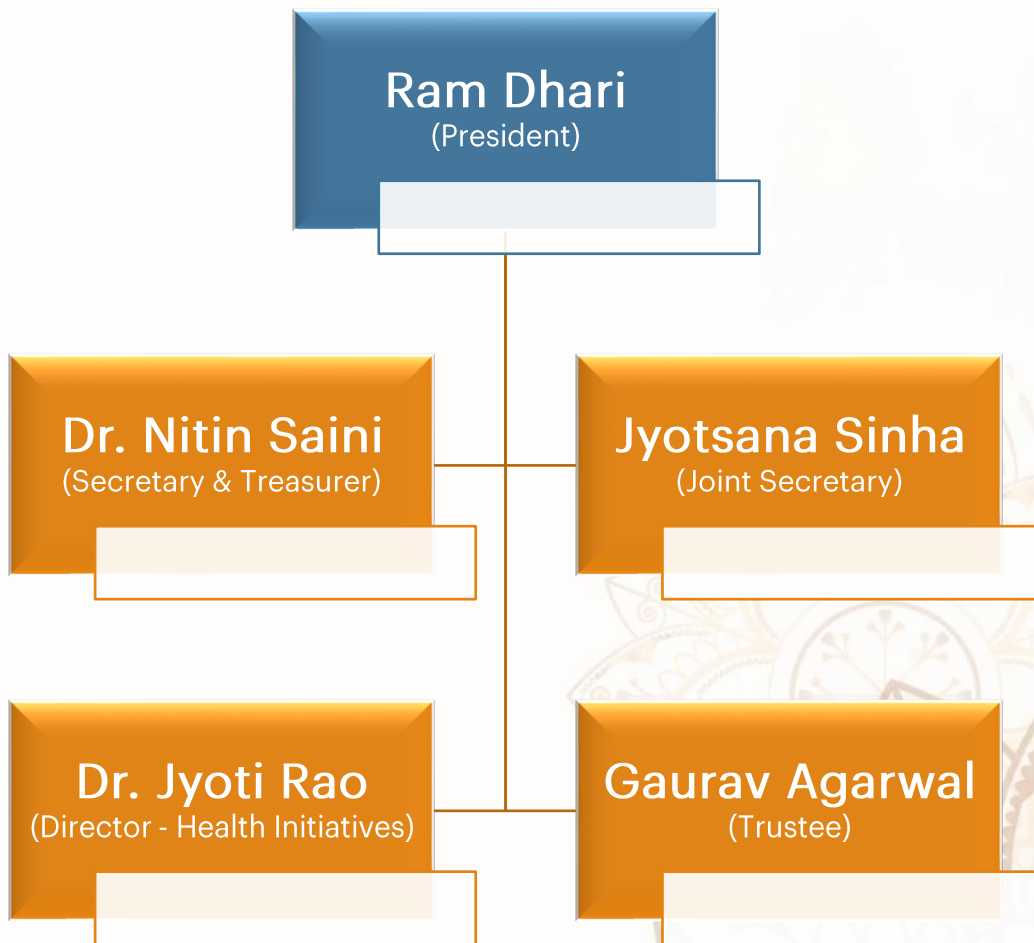

The reporting period, from April 2024 to September 2024, has been a remarkable period for the Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation), marked by significant progress and impactful achievements across all our focus areas: Education, Health, Environment, and Community Development. We have strived to empower individuals, foster sustainable practices, and create a positive impact on society.

Educational Initiatives

- **Donation of Computers and Laptops:** SAS Foundation made a substantial contribution to educational infrastructure by donating 15 desktops and 15 laptops, benefiting over 3,000 students across various institutions. These devices were donated to Government Co-ed Sarvodaya Vidyalaya and ETASHA Society, providing vital tools for enhancing digital literacy and computer skills among underprivileged youth.

Internship Programs:

- **Green Champions Internship:** This program educated 21 students on the harmful effects of e-waste and the importance of recycling. The participants were actively involved in e-waste collection drives, further promoting environmental responsibility.
- **IT Internship:** This initiative empowered 13 students with skills in website creation and maintenance using WIX, contributing to their employability and technical proficiency.

Webinars and Online Learning:

- SAS Foundation collaborated with JV Edtech Medovation to organize six online webinars covering diverse topics such as Hypertension, Women Safety, Alzheimer's Awareness, and more, reaching hundreds of participants. These sessions raised awareness on important health and safety issues while promoting digital learning.

Health Initiatives

- A series of online webinars were organized to spread awareness on critical health issues such as Hypertension, Alzheimer's, and the Complexities of the Brain. These sessions saw active participation from nearly 200 individuals, equipping them with valuable knowledge on prevention, symptoms, and management of these conditions.
- Women's Safety Webinar: Reaching 110 participants, this session focused on strengthening the understanding of women's rights and the laws protecting them, empowering the participants with knowledge to combat gender-based violence and discrimination.

Environmental Initiatives

- **E-Waste Collection Drives:** SAS Foundation made significant strides in environmental sustainability by organizing multiple e-waste collection drives in association with Attero Recycling. These drives were held across various residential societies, successfully collecting over 1.39 tonnes of e-waste for safe disposal and recycling. These

- efforts contributed to reducing environmental hazards and promoting responsible disposal of electronic waste.
- **Plantathon (Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam campaign):** As part of Van Mahotsav, SAS Foundation organized a plantation drive at ITL Public School, where 15 trees were planted by students and staff. This initiative aimed at increasing green cover, promoting biodiversity, and fostering environmental stewardship among youth.

Community Development Initiatives

- **Supporting Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center:** SAS Foundation made several in-kind donations, including groceries and essential items worth ₹ 39,018, positively impacting the lives of visually impaired individuals. These efforts contributed to their well-being and provided crucial support to this marginalized group.
- **Renovation of Shiv Mandir, Palam:** Community support initiatives included the renovation of the local Shiv Mandir in Palam. Key projects such as PVC panel installation, idol enclosures, and new water pumping systems were undertaken, benefiting over 200 residents. These efforts helped preserve the cultural heritage of the community while ensuring a functional and welcoming space for religious gatherings.
- **Akhand Ram Charit Manas Path and Bhandara:** SAS Foundation organized a spiritual event that brought together around 350 members of the community. The event concluded with a Prasad

Bhandara, fostering community bonds and promoting cultural preservation.

Collaborations and Partnerships

- SAS Foundation strengthened its collaborations with JV Edtech Medovation, jointly organizing six webinars on topics ranging from health awareness to environmental conservation. The partnership with Attero Recycling also continued to flourish, facilitating several successful e-waste collection drives.

Through our relentless efforts and dedication, SAS Foundation has made a substantial impact on the lives of thousands of individuals. We are proud of the progress made this year and remain committed to expanding our reach and initiatives in the coming years.

During the reporting period, April 2024 to September 2024, the Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) implemented several key projects aimed at addressing critical social issues across the areas of education, health, environment, and community development. These initiatives have created meaningful change and have brought us closer to our mission of empowering youth and fostering community development. Below is an overview of our major projects, their outcomes, and the impact they have generated.

1. Education Projects

- **Project: Computer Literacy Drive**
 - **Objective:** To bridge the digital divide by providing underprivileged students access to computers and digital literacy resources.
 - **Outcome:** Donation of 15 desktops and 15 laptops to educational institutions like Government Co-ed Sarvodaya Vidyalaya and ETASHA Society, enabling better digital education for over 3,000 students.
 - **Impact:** Improved access to technology has enhanced learning experiences, particularly in IT and digital literacy, empowering students with essential 21st-century skills.

- **Project: Green Champions and IT Internships**
 - **Objective:** To create awareness among students about environmental responsibility and to provide technical skills related to website development.
 - **Outcome:**
 - **Green Champions Internship:** 21 students participated and learned about e-waste pollution and recycling.
 - **IT Internship:** 13 students developed proficiency in website creation using WIX.
 - **Impact:** Students became ambassadors of environmental sustainability and digital empowerment, fostering a sense of responsibility towards societal and environmental issues.

- **Project: Webinars on Education and Awareness**
 - **Objective:** To disseminate critical knowledge through online platforms and engage participants in discussions on health, safety, and digital literacy.
 - **Outcome:** A series of six webinars were organized in collaboration with JV Edtech Medovation, covering topics like hypertension, Alzheimer's, brain complexities, and women's safety. These webinars reached a total of 290 participants.

- **Impact:** Participants gained critical awareness on important social and health issues, contributing to informed communities and proactive health management.

2. Health Projects

- **Project: Health Awareness Webinars**
 - **Objective:** To raise awareness about non-communicable diseases and issues related to mental and physical health.
 - **Outcome:** Over 160 participants benefitted from webinars on Hypertension, Alzheimer's, and Brain Complexities. These webinars educated attendees on preventive care, treatment options, and ways to manage health risks.
 - **Impact:** Heightened awareness among participants about the importance of early detection, healthy lifestyles, and mental well-being has fostered a more health-conscious community.
- **Project: Women's Safety and Rights Webinar**
 - **Objective:** To educate women about their legal rights and ensure safety in their personal and professional lives.
 - **Outcome:** The session engaged 110 participants, providing them with crucial knowledge about laws protecting women's rights and practical steps to safeguard themselves.

- **Impact:** The webinar empowered women with legal literacy and knowledge of available resources, fostering greater confidence and security in both personal and societal spaces.

3. Environment Projects

- **Project: E-Waste Collection Drives**
 - **Objective:** To promote the proper disposal and recycling of electronic waste to reduce environmental hazards.
 - **Outcome:** 12 successful e-waste collection drives were conducted in collaboration with Attero Recycling, across multiple residential societies, collecting over 1.39 tonnes of e-waste for recycling. Societies in Dwarka and Faridabad were particularly active participants.
 - **Impact:** The drives contributed to reducing environmental pollution caused by improper disposal of e-waste. These initiatives also created awareness among communities about sustainable **waste management practices**.
- **Project: Plantathon 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam'**
 - **Objective:** To promote environmental consciousness by engaging students and the community in tree planting.

- **Outcome:** 15 trees were planted during the Van Mahotsav at ITL Public School, engaging students, staff, and the local community in the activity.
- **Impact:** This project fostered a culture of environmental stewardship among youth, contributing to the enhancement of green cover and promoting biodiversity in the local area.

4. Community Development Projects

- **Project: Support for Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center**
 - **Objective:** To support the visually impaired with essential supplies and resources.
 - **Outcome:** Donations worth ₹ 39,018 were provided in the form of groceries and essential items to the Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center, benefiting its residents.
 - **Impact:** The initiative provided vital support to visually impaired individuals, improving their quality of life and enabling the hostel to better meet the needs of its residents.
- **Project: Renovation of Shiv Mandir in Palam**
 - **Objective:** To support community-based spiritual and cultural activities by enhancing local religious infrastructure.

- **Outcome:** Major renovations, including the installation of PVC panels, idol enclosures, and water pumping systems, were completed, benefitting over 200 community members.
- **Impact:** The renovation project has strengthened community bonds, creating a more welcoming and functional space for religious gatherings and cultural preservation.
- **Project: Akhand Ram Charit Manas Path**
 - **Objective:** To foster spiritual growth and community interaction through religious and cultural events.
 - **Outcome:** The event brought together 350 individuals who participated in the Akhand Ramayan Path followed by a Prasad Bhandara.
 - **Impact:** The project reinforced community ties and promoted cultural and spiritual enrichment among the participants, fostering a sense of belonging and collective identity.

The initiatives undertaken by SAS Foundation during the fiscal year have yielded measurable and meaningful outcomes. Our projects have successfully impacted over 5,000 lives, contributing to educational advancement, improved health awareness, environmental protection, and community development. Each project has empowered individuals, uplifted communities, and fostered sustainable practices, bringing us

closer to our mission of creating a socially responsible and empowered society.

Our achievements underscore the importance of sustained efforts and collaboration in driving positive change, and we remain committed to scaling these initiatives in the years ahead.

For the reporting period, April 2024 to September 2024, the Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) effectively managed its financial resources to achieve its organizational goals. Despite operating with a modest budget, the Foundation's financial strategy has ensured the successful implementation of its core projects and initiatives, focusing on education, environment, health, and community development.

Sources of Funding

The primary sources of funding for the SAS Foundation during this fiscal year were as follows:

- **In-Kind Donations: ₹ 6,00,000.00**

The most significant source of funding came in the form of in-kind donations, which were primarily used for projects related to educational initiatives and community support. These donations included computers, supplies for the blind hostel, and materials for temple renovations.

- **Donations from Trustees: ₹ 3,07,383.30**

Contributions from the trustees were the second major source of funding. These donations played a crucial role in supporting ongoing projects and ensuring the smooth functioning of the Foundation's initiatives.

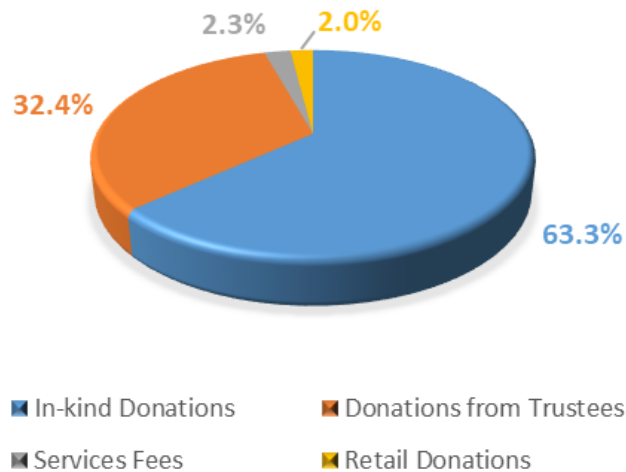
- **Service Fees: ₹ 22,082.00**

Revenue was generated through fees charged for services provided by the Foundation, including internships and webinars. This income helped to offset some of the operational costs.

- **Retail Donations: ₹ 18,844.00**

Small donations from individuals contributed to the Foundation's retail donation pool. These funds were instrumental in covering minor expenses for community-driven projects.

SOURCES OF FUNDING



Expenditure Overview

The Foundation's total expenditure for the fiscal year amounted to ₹ 7,75,840.44, which was allocated across various projects and operational activities. Below is a detailed breakdown of expenses:

- **NGO Initiatives: ₹ 7,56,087.00**

A significant portion of the expenses was dedicated to the Foundation's initiatives, covering projects in education, environment, health, and community development. These funds were instrumental in driving the impact of the organization's core programs.

- **Educational Initiatives: ₹ 6,02,450.00**

The largest portion of initiative expenses was directed towards educational projects, including the donation of laptops and desktops, Green Champions and IT internships, and awareness-building webinars. These initiatives had the most substantial outreach and impact.

- **Community Development Initiatives: ₹ 1,52,221.00**

Investments in community development supported projects such as the renovation of Shiv Mandir and assistance for the Rashtriya Blind Hostel, which played a pivotal role in enhancing the living conditions of underserved groups.

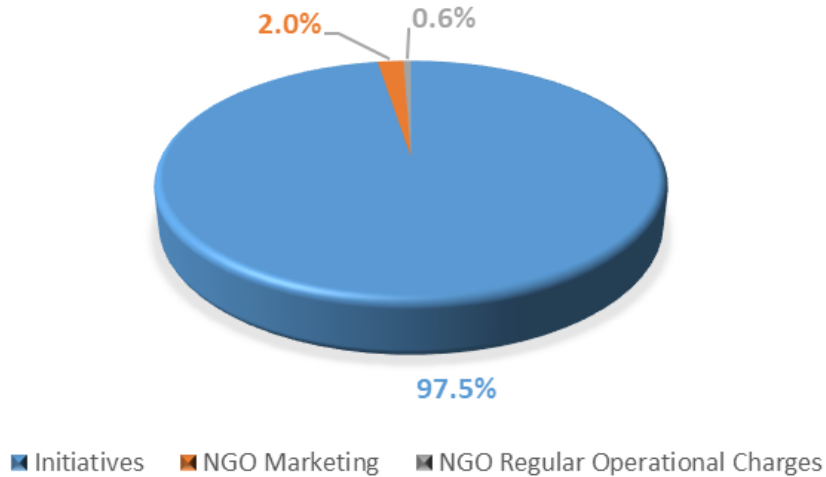
- **Environmental Initiatives: ₹ 1,416.00**
This category covered expenses for the Plantathon event and e-waste collection drives. These projects focused on raising environmental awareness and sustainable practices in the community.

- **Health Initiatives: ₹ 0.00**
Although the Foundation conducted health awareness webinars, no expenses were incurred in this category during the fiscal year due to the online format of the initiatives, which minimized costs.

- **NGO Marketing: ₹ 15,230.00**
This expenditure covered promotional and marketing activities aimed at increasing visibility and outreach for the Foundation's programs. Marketing efforts included social media promotions, the design of event banners, and website maintenance.

- **Operational Charges: ₹ 4,523.44**
Operational costs were kept to a minimum, covering essential administrative expenses such as utilities, stationery, and banking fees. This allowed the Foundation to focus the majority of its budget on impact-driven initiatives.

In the reporting period of April 2024 to September 2024, the Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) forged key partnerships and collaborations that enabled it to scale its impact across its core areas of education, environment, health, and community development. These partnerships, both institutional and community-driven, played a crucial role in strengthening the Foundation's outreach and effectiveness, bringing together diverse resources and expertise for maximum impact.

1. JV Edtech Medovation

One of the most notable partnerships this year was with **JV Edtech Medovation**, an organization focused on advancing education and technology. Together, SAS Foundation and JV Edtech Medovation organized **six online webinars** on critical topics including women's rights, brain health, Alzheimer's awareness, hypertension, and environmental sustainability. These webinars collectively engaged over **300 participants**, making a significant contribution to public awareness and education on vital social and health issues.

In addition to webinars, the two organizations partnered for an **e-waste collection drive**, furthering their shared commitment to environmental sustainability. This collaboration highlighted the importance of responsible e-waste disposal, fostering a sense of environmental stewardship within communities.

2. ETASHA Society

SAS Foundation continued its partnership with **ETASHA Society**, an organization committed to vocational training for underprivileged youth. This fiscal year, SAS Foundation arranged the donation of **15 laptops** from TCS to ETASHA Society, facilitating the setup of a **youth computer literacy training center**. The initiative underscores the Foundation's long-term commitment to empowering young people through access to technology and digital skills training, contributing to the economic and social development of underserved communities.

3. Attero Recycling Pvt. Ltd.

SAS Foundation partnered with **Attero Recycling Pvt. Ltd.**, India's leading e-waste management company, to organize a series of **e-waste collection drives** in Faridabad and Dwarka. This collaboration resulted in the collection of **1.39 tonnes of e-waste**, which included electronic devices like smartphones, laptops, printers, and more. The partnership ensured that collected e-waste was recycled responsibly, reducing the harmful environmental impact of electronic waste. Together, SAS Foundation and Attero raised significant awareness about the importance of sustainable e-waste management in residential communities.

4. BGS International Public School

The collaboration between SAS Foundation and **BGS International Public School** brought about two impactful internship programs: the **Green Champions Internship** and the **IT Internship**. These programs provided students with hands-on experience in fields such as pollution control, e-waste management, and website creation. The **Green Champions Internship** saw the participation of **21 students**, while **13 students** enrolled in the **IT Internship**.

Through this partnership, students were able to gain practical knowledge and skills in sustainability and technology, thereby enhancing their readiness for future careers. This collaboration represents SAS Foundation's commitment to engaging youth in education and experiential learning, fostering the next generation of leaders in environmental conservation and IT.

5. ITL Public School

Another significant partnership was established with **ITL Public School**, where SAS Foundation conducted a tree plantation drive as part of "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam" campaign as part of the **Van Mahotsav** celebrations. During this drive, **15 trees** were planted, involving the active participation of students, staff, and the broader community. This initiative not only contributed to the school's environmental education efforts but also helped inculcate a sense of responsibility towards nature among young learners.

The collaboration with ITL Public School is a prime example of how SAS Foundation integrates environmental consciousness into educational environments, helping to shape environmentally responsible future citizens.

6. Govt Co-Ed Sarvodaya Vidyalaya (GSV)

As part of its educational initiatives, SAS Foundation also partnered with **Govt Co-Ed Sarvodaya Vidyalaya (GSV)** and donated **15 desktops** to the school to support its digital education programs. In **BPTP Park Floor II, DLF Silver Oaks Apartments, Aishwaryam Apartments, Auralis Twins, Ranjit Vihar II, and Adel Divine Court**, the Foundation worked closely with community leaders to raise awareness about the environmental hazards of improper e-waste disposal and mobilized residents to contribute.

Through these partnerships with community leaders such as **Anoop Gautam, Sudhakar Jain, Pradeep Menon, Jayaprakash Kotkar, Mridul and**

Abhishek Dwivedi, SAS Foundation was able to impact over **200 households** and successfully collect a significant amount of e-waste for recycling. These collaborations underscore the power of community action in driving environmental sustainability.

8. Temple and Hostel Collaborations

SAS Foundation extended its reach into cultural and community development through its partnerships with local religious and social institutions. The Foundation organized an **Akhand Ramayan Path** at **Shiv Mandir in Palam**, where over **350 people** participated in this spiritual and cultural event. Similarly, the Foundation collaborated with the **Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center**, providing critical support for the renovation of the hostel's infrastructure, which improved the living conditions for visually impaired residents.

As Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) looks toward the future, it remains committed to expanding its impact across its four core focus areas: education, health, environment, and community development. Leveraging the momentum gained through its successful initiatives and collaborations, the Foundation aims to launch new projects and enhance existing programs to create sustainable, long-lasting change in society.

1. Expansion of Educational Initiatives

Building on the success of its technology donations and vocational training programs, SAS Foundation plans to introduce a comprehensive **Digital Literacy Initiative** for underprivileged students. This initiative will provide them with essential skills in coding, web development, and digital marketing, bridging the digital divide for those with limited access to technology. The Foundation is also working towards expanding its internship programs, such as the **IT and Green Champions Internships**, to more schools and communities, with a focus on experiential learning and career readiness.

In addition, SAS Foundation is exploring collaborations with more corporate partners for the **donation of devices like laptops and desktops** to rural schools and educational institutions, ensuring that students in marginalized areas gain access to quality education.

2. E-Waste Collection and Recycling Expansion

Given the success of its **e-waste collection drives**, SAS Foundation aims to expand its environmental efforts by organizing **nationwide e-waste collection campaigns**. These drives will target residential communities, educational institutions, and corporate offices, with the goal of raising awareness about sustainable e-waste disposal and recycling. The Foundation also plans to develop educational modules and workshops on e-waste management for school students and communities, creating future environmental advocates.

In collaboration with partners like **Attero Recycling**, the Foundation plans to increase its annual collection target, aiming to divert more than **2 tonnes of e-waste** from landfills by 2025.

3. Health and Well-being Initiatives

Recognizing the growing need for accessible healthcare information, SAS Foundation is planning a series of **community health camps** and **awareness webinars** on critical topics such as **mental health**, **women's health**, and **non-communicable diseases** like diabetes and hypertension. These health camps will provide free medical check-ups, consultations, and health screenings for underprivileged communities, with a focus on early detection and prevention of common health issues.

In addition, the Foundation intends to collaborate with health professionals and organizations to provide **telemedicine services** to rural areas, ensuring that underserved populations have access to quality healthcare without geographical barriers.

4. Community Development Projects

In line with its commitment to community development, SAS Foundation is planning to launch the **Skill Development for Livelihoods Initiative**, aimed at empowering marginalized youth and women with skills in areas such as tailoring, handicrafts, and digital entrepreneurship. This initiative will create avenues for economic independence and improved living conditions, particularly for those from rural and underserved areas.

The Foundation also plans to expand its cultural and spiritual programs by organizing more community events like the **Akhand Ramayan Path**, fostering social cohesion and strengthening the cultural fabric of communities.

5. Enhanced Collaborations and National Outreach
