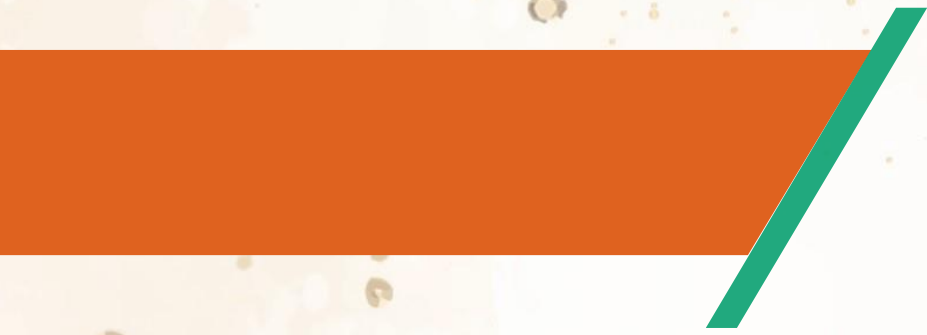

Executive Summary

- Recent accomplishments include significant community development initiatives and unwavering support to underprivileged and persons with disabilities (PWD) communities.

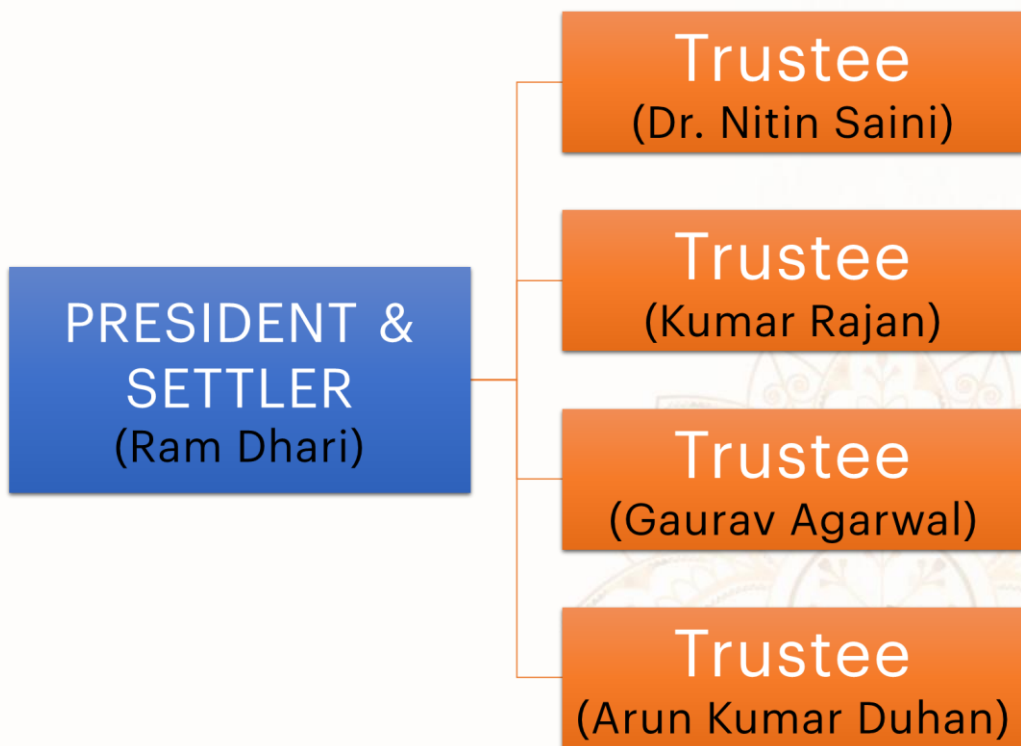
Objectives and Focus Areas

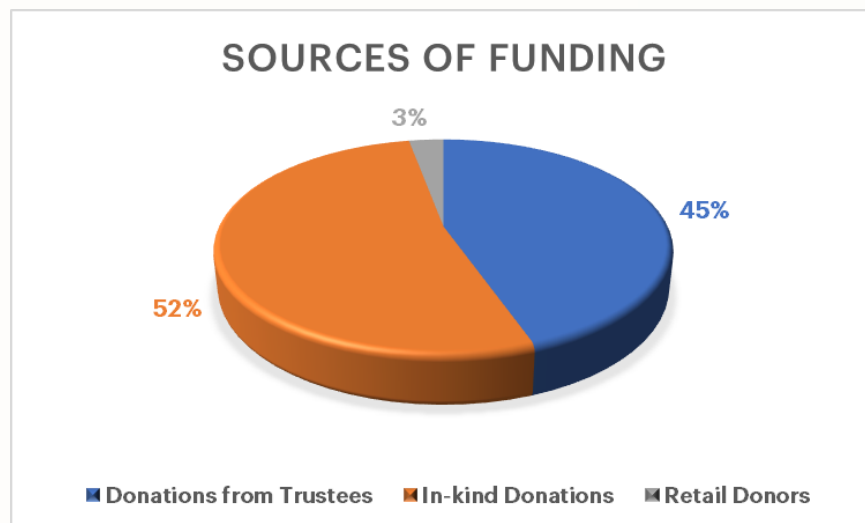

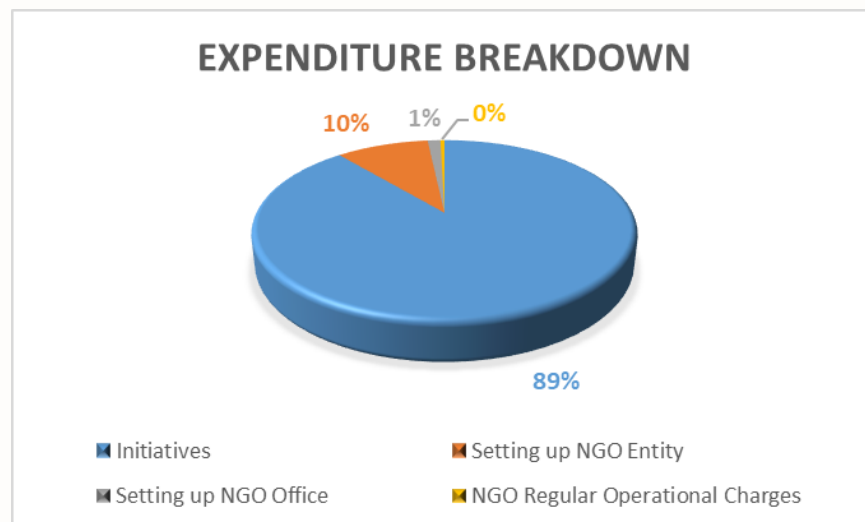

During the reporting period, from October 1, 2022, to March 31, 2023, Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation managed its financial resources with prudence and transparency. Here's a summary of our financial activities:

Total Income:

- The foundation received a total income of **Rs. 551,030.50**, comprising donations from various sources. The primary income sources were generous contributions from our dedicated trustees, totaling **Rs. 245,552.50**, and substantial in-kind donations worth **Rs. 289,323.00**. Additionally, retail donors extended their support with contributions amounting to **Rs. 16,155.00**.

Total Expenditure:

- We allocated a total expenditure of **Rs. 438,859.69** towards various NGO activities that align with our mission and objectives. The majority of our expenses, totaling **Rs. 390,404.00**, were directed towards executing diverse initiatives aimed at uplifting communities and empowering youth. In addition, the amount of **Rs. 41,295.12** was utilized for the setup of the NGO entity, **Rs. 5,738.00** for the establishment of our office, and **Rs. 1,422.09** for regular operational charges.

Net Financial Position:

- At the conclusion of this reporting period, the foundation maintains a net financial position of Rs. **112,170.81**, representing the difference between total income and total expenditure.

Key Financial Highlights:

- Notably, during this period, the foundation encountered a financial challenge related to the Makar Sankranti Bhandara Initiative. Despite the initiative's significance and its positive impact on the community, donations, both in cash and in-kind, were relatively limited. Consequently, the entire set of expenses for this initiative was borne by the NGO.




