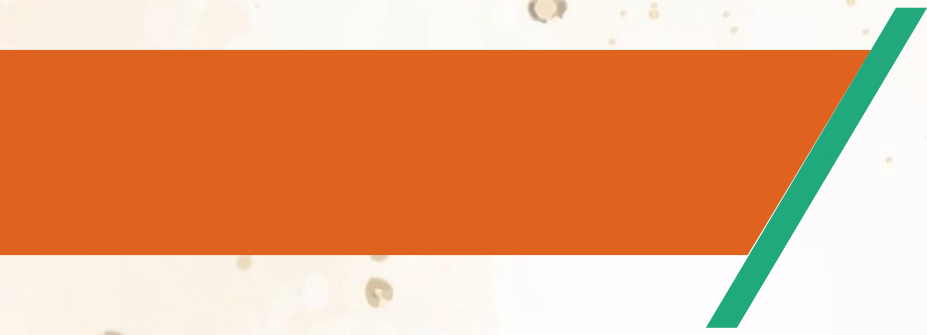

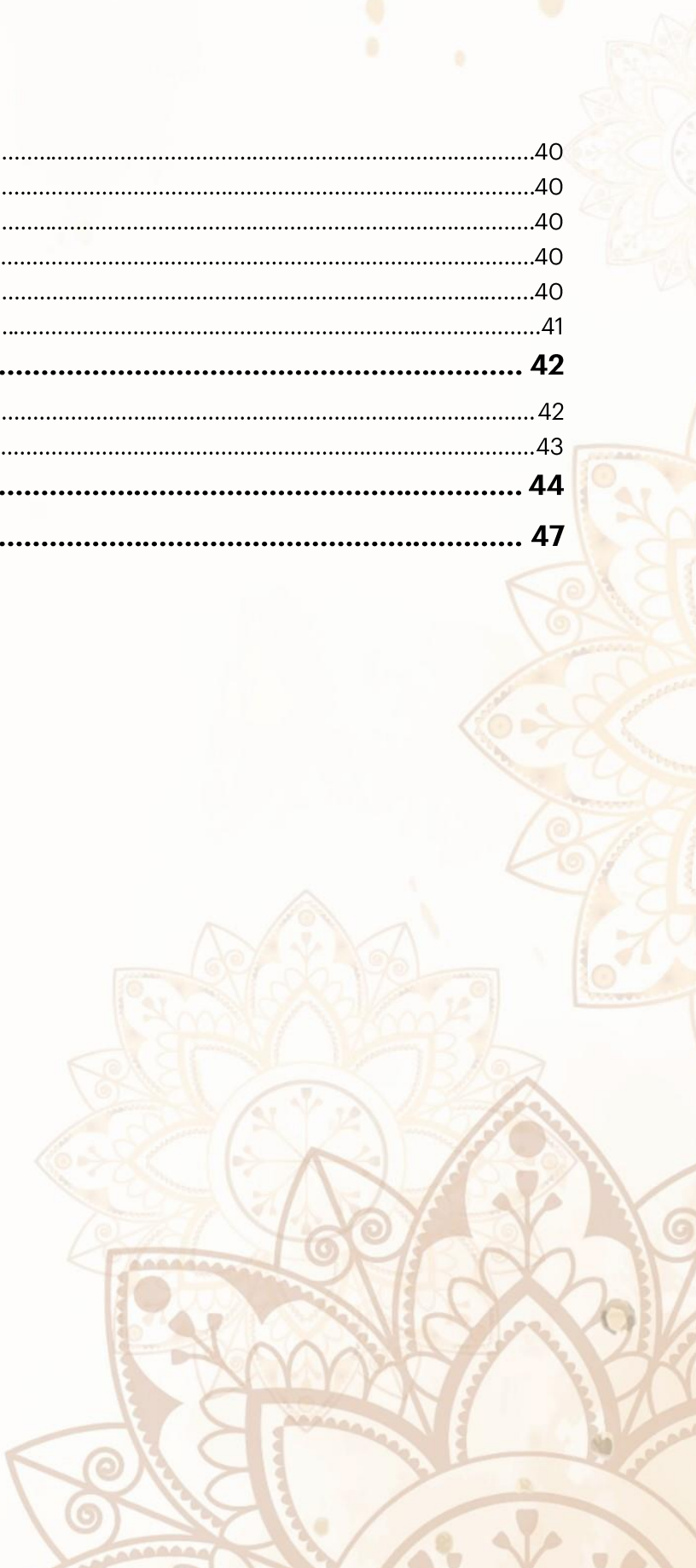

Executive Summary

During the reporting period from October 2023 to March 2024, SAS Foundation continued its unwavering dedication to uplift communities and individuals across its focus areas of education, health, environment, and community development. Despite the challenges posed by the ongoing pandemic and other socio-economic factors, the foundation remained steadfast in its mission to empower and improve the lives of those in need.

One of the key highlights of this period was the regular distribution of ration worth Rs. 18,722 to the Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center (RHBTC), benefiting 40 lives each time. This initiative not only provided essential sustenance but also underscored the foundation's commitment to inclusivity and support for marginalized communities.

Additionally, the establishment of a Community Library at Shiv Mandir in Palam, Delhi, marked a significant step towards enhancing educational opportunities for local residents. With approximately 200 individuals benefitting from the library's resources and the regular donation of sacred books on every Poornima, SAS Foundation demonstrated its dedication to promoting knowledge dissemination and cultural enrichment.

Participation in cultural celebrations at Venkateshwara International School, Dwarka, Delhi, further exemplified the foundation's commitment to fostering community engagement and cultural exchange. Through the support of the Assam Showcase at the "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat" event, SAS Foundation touched the lives of 1,200 students, showcasing the rich diversity and heritage of India.

In the realm of education and professional development, the foundation organized a Cybersecurity Series Lecture in collaboration with CRAC Learning and IEEE WIE at Maharaja Surajmal Institute of Technology (MSIT), Delhi. With 154 attendees comprising students and working professionals, this initiative aimed to equip individuals with valuable skills and knowledge in a rapidly evolving digital landscape.

Furthermore, SAS Foundation extended its support to vocational training programs, orphanages, and community outreach initiatives, positively impacting the lives of countless individuals. From clothes donation drives to temple renovations, each endeavor reflected the foundation's ethos of compassion, empowerment, and service.

The period also witnessed notable accolades, with key members of SAS Foundation receiving prestigious awards in recognition of their contributions to community and nation-building. Nitin Saini, Secretary of SAS Foundation, was honored with the Yugdhara Global Achiever's Award 2023, while Jyotsana Sinha, Joint Secretary, received the Nature's Grace Achiever's Award 2023, underscoring the foundation's impact and leadership in driving positive change.

Since its inception, SAS Foundation has been committed to fostering positive change in communities through various initiatives focused on education, health, environment, and community development.

The foundation's mission stems from the belief that by empowering youth, it can catalyze sustainable development and create a better future for all. Over the years, SAS Foundation has achieved significant milestones in community development and has provided support to underprivileged and persons with disabilities (PWD) communities, making a tangible impact on the lives of individuals across diverse backgrounds.



Objectives and Focus Areas

The core objectives of SAS Foundation revolve around empowering youth across four focus areas: education, health, environment, and community development. 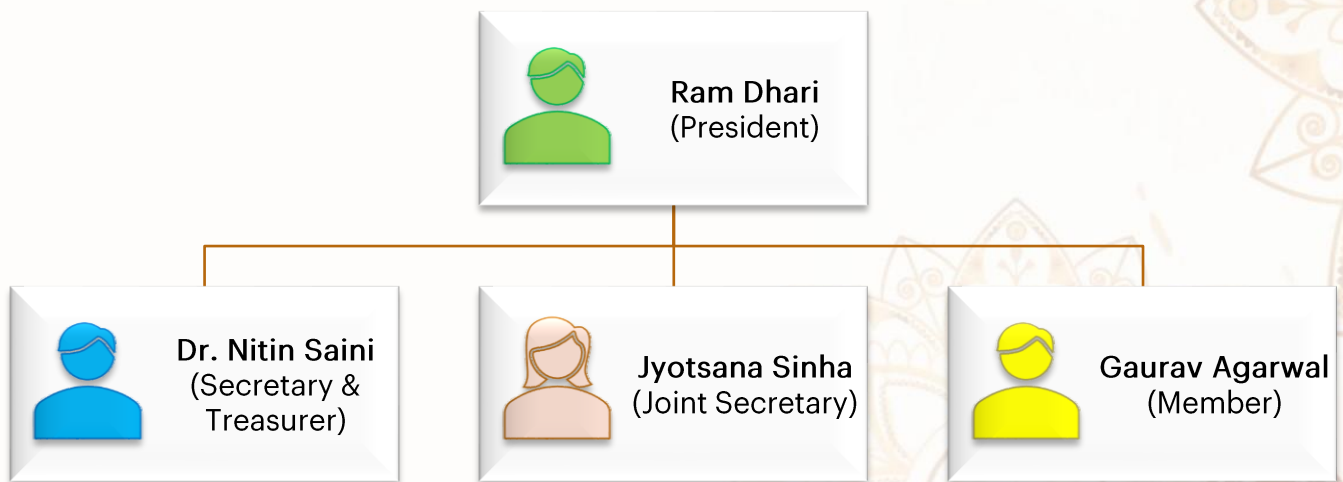
The foundation's primary focus remains on education, health, environment, and community development, recognizing these as fundamental pillars for

During the reporting period from October 2023 to March 2024, Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) achieved significant progress and notable accomplishments across its focus areas of education, health, environment, and community development. Some of the key achievements include:

1. Regular Ration Distribution to Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center (RHBTC):

- SAS Foundation facilitated regular ration distribution worth Rs. 18,722 to RHBTC, benefiting 40 visually impaired students with essential supplies each time.

2. Establishment of Community Library in Shiv Mandir, Palam, Delhi:

- A community library was established in Shiv Mandir, Palam, Delhi, reaching out to 200 individuals who can now access educational resources and reading materials. Additionally, the foundation donated sacred books on every Poornima, enriching the cultural and spiritual environment of the community.

3. Support for Assam Showcase at "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat" Cultural Celebrations:

- SAS Foundation supported the Assam Showcase at cultural celebrations held at Venkateshwara International School, Dwarka, Delhi, impacting the lives of 1,200 students through cultural exchange and awareness.

4. Cybersecurity Series Lecture at Maharaja Surajmal Institute of Technology (MSIT):

- In collaboration with CRAC Learning and IEEE WIE, SAS Foundation conducted a cybersecurity series lecture at MSIT, Delhi, reaching 154 attendees comprising students and working professionals, thereby enhancing their knowledge and skills in cybersecurity.

5. Guest of Honor at Etasha Society Event:

- The foundation was invited as the Guest of Honor at an event organized by Etasha Society, celebrating the successful completion of a vocational training program, positively impacting 51 individuals.

6. Clothes Donation Drive and Distribution:

- SAS Foundation organized clothes donation drives at Kautilya Apartments and Mahajan Society in Dwarka, Delhi, collecting over 1,500 usable clothes valued at more than Rs. 7 Lakhs. These clothes were then distributed through Sewa Bharti NGO, benefiting 750 beneficiaries.

7. Renovation of Garbh Griha in Shiv Mandir, Palam:

- The foundation renovated the garbh griha of Shiv Mandir, Palam, Delhi, installing PVC panels on all walls, enhancing the spiritual experience for 200 devotees in the neighborhood.

8. Distribution of Blankets, Toothbrushes, and Stationery:

- Blankets, toothbrushes, and stationery worth a total of Rs. 36,685 were distributed during the reporting period. This distribution included items provided to blind student residents at RBHTC, as well as to orphanages like Don Bosco Ashalayam and Sneha Auxilium, benefiting a total of 145 individuals.

These achievements reflect SAS Foundation's commitment to making a positive impact on the lives of individuals and communities. The foundation's dedication to its mission and values continues to drive meaningful change and empowerment.

1. Education Initiatives

- **Established Community Library in Shiv Mandir, Palam, Delhi:** This initiative has touched the lives of 200 individuals, providing access to educational resources and promoting literacy within the community. Additionally, the regular donation of sacred books on every Poornima enhances the cultural and spiritual environment.
- **Supported Assam Showcase at "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat" Cultural Celebrations:** SAS Foundation's support for this cultural event at Venkateshwara International School, Dwarka, Delhi, impacted 1,200 students, fostering cultural exchange and awareness.
- **Conducted Cybersecurity Series Lecture at Maharaja Surajmal Institute of Technology (MSIT), Delhi:** In association with CRAC Learning and IEEE WIE, SAS Foundation conducted a cybersecurity series lecture, touching the lives of 154 attendees comprising students and working professionals.
- **Provided Educational Support:** SAS Foundation distributed blankets & stationery worth Rs. 24,755 to Don Bosco Ashalayam Orphanage and Sneha Auxilium Orphanage, enhancing the lives of 105 orphan boys and girls residing in both hostels. Additionally, the foundation supported the education of a girl from the economically

weaker section (EWS) by providing a used laptop, enabling her to prepare for CA entrance exams.

2. Health Initiatives

- **Contributed towards Repair & Maintenance of Washrooms at RBHTC:** This initiative benefits 40 blind student residents in the hostel by improving sanitation facilities.
- **Distributed Blankets & Toothbrushes to Blind Student Residents at RBHTC:** SAS Foundation distributed blankets & toothbrushes worth Rs. 11,930, touching the lives of 40 visually impaired students.

3. Environment Initiatives

- **Organized e-Waste Collection Drive:** In collaboration with Attero Recycling Pvt Ltd, SAS Foundation organized an e-Waste Collection Drive in three residential societies of Dwarka, Delhi, resulting in the collection of 17 electronic items and 19 kgs of miscellaneous e-waste.

4. Community Development Initiatives

- **Regular Ration Distribution to Rashtriya Blind Hostel and Training Center (RHBTC):** SAS Foundation facilitated regular ration distribution worth Rs. 18,722 to RHBTC, touching the lives of 40 visually impaired students each time.

- **Organized Clothes Donation Drive:** Through donation drives at Kautilya Apartments and Mahajan Society in Dwarka, Delhi, SAS Foundation collected over 1,500 usable clothes worth more than Rs. 7 Lakhs, benefiting 750 beneficiaries.
- **Renovated Garbh Griha in Shiv Mandir, Palam, Delhi:** The renovation of the garbh griha with PVC panels on all walls benefits the lives of 200 devotees in the neighborhood.
- **Distributed Food Packs:** SAS Foundation distributed food packs worth Rs. 8,284 on the occasion of Makar Sankranti to house helps, sweepers, cobblers, and other individuals from the EWS community.
- **Celebrated Pran Pratishtha and Inauguration of Ram Mandir Temple:** SAS Foundation distributed 50 Kg laddoos worth Rs. 4,620 in the neighborhood of Raj Nagar, Palam, Delhi, as part of the temple inauguration celebration.

These initiatives demonstrate SAS Foundation's multifaceted approach to addressing societal challenges and empowering communities across education, health, environment, and community development sectors.

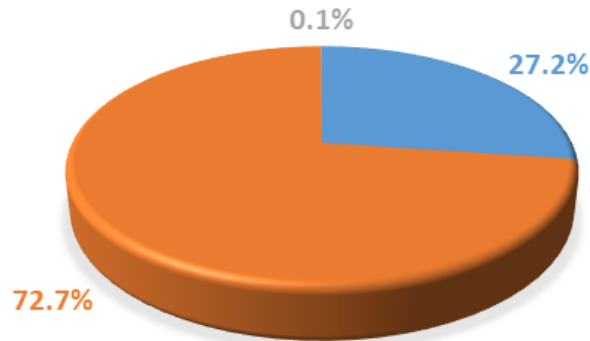

SOURCES OF FUNDING



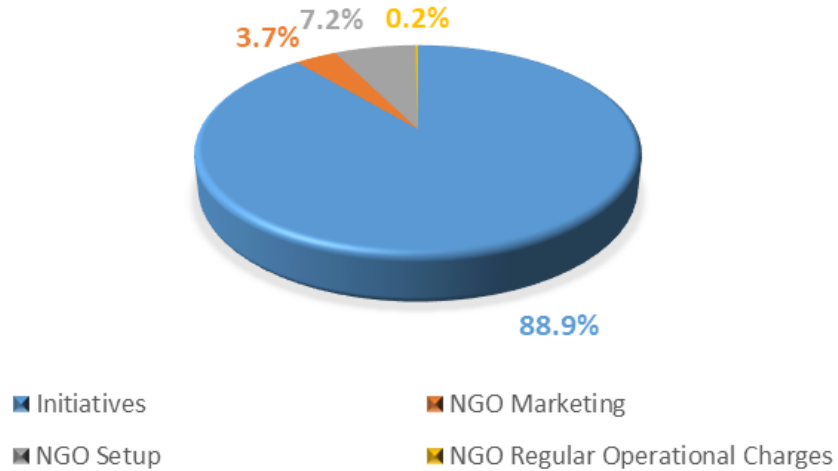
■ Donations from Trustees ■ In-kind Donations ■ Retail Donations


