Executive Summary

The reporting period from **October 2024 to March 2025** marked a significant phase of growth, outreach, and consolidation for the **SAS Foundation**, a youth-centric non-profit organization committed to driving change across four key sectors: **Education, Environment, Health, and Community Development**.

During this six-month period, the foundation directly impacted **8,606 new lives**, bringing the total cumulative impact to **101,728 lives**. This was made possible through a series of strategic programs, awareness campaigns, grassroots interventions, collaborations, and responsible governance. Key initiatives included e-waste collection drives across multiple cities, financial support for cancer treatment and tuition fees, faculty development sessions, book donations, and celebration of International Women's Day, among others.

Some of the highlights from this period include:

- **Education:** 6 impactful programs including book donations, lectures, and training sessions, touching **278 lives**.
- **Environment:** 6 e-waste drives conducted across **Gurgaon, Faridabad, Bangalore, and Noida**, resulting in **1,049 kg of e-waste** collected and **258 lives** sensitized.
- **Health:** 4 targeted health programs supported **243 individuals**, including cancer patients, health webinar participants, and sports beneficiaries.
- **Community Development:** 4 initiatives including ration donations and digital workshops reached **109 individuals**.

The foundation also strengthened its strategic partnerships, including signing an MoU with **Shihaan Tech Global Pvt. Ltd.** to conduct monthly lectures and podcasts to enhance youth engagement. Transparency and governance remained a priority, as reflected in the clear financial overview, donor accountability, and independent audits.

Significant contributions from the leadership team—**Dr. Nitin Saini, Dr. Jyoti Rao, Ram Dhari, Jyotsana Sinha, Gaurav Agarwal,** and volunteers like **Shravan Dabi**—played a crucial role in the success of these initiatives.

The period also saw **media coverage** for the foundation's e-waste collection drive in Faridabad and the release of an **impact infographic** summarizing the foundation's reach and performance.

SAS Foundation enters the next phase with reinforced momentum, strategic clarity, and a deepened commitment to its mission of empowering youth and building a resilient, inclusive, and sustainable future for all.

History and Background

Swavalamban Avam Swabhimaan Foundation (SAS Foundation) was established on **9th September 2022** with the vision of empowering youth and underserved communities through impactful interventions across **education, health, environment, and community development**. The Foundation was conceptualized as a grassroots-driven initiative committed to enabling self-reliance (*Swavalamban*) and dignity (*Swabhimaan*) among the citizens of India.

The NGO was founded by a group of socially conscious professionals and retired government officers who brought a deep understanding of public welfare, governance, and community engagement. Among them, **Dr. Nitin Saini**, a visionary leader with a background in IT and social entrepreneurship, assumed the role of **Managing Trustee**, overseeing strategy, execution, and partnerships. **Mr. Ram Dhari**, who retired as a Senior Accounts Officer from the Defence Accounts Department, became the **President and Settler**, anchoring the organization in principles of public accountability and service.

Initially, the Foundation was co-governed by trustees **Arun Duhan** and **Kumar Rajan**, who played a role in the formative phase of the organization. In alignment with the evolving priorities of SAS Foundation and its expanding portfolio, the board underwent restructuring in 2023 and 2024. Accordingly, **Ms. Jyotsana Sinha** replaced **Arun Duhan** in April 2023, and **Dr. Jyoti Rao** replaced **Kumar Rajan** in April 2024. These transitions brought new energy and specialized expertise to the leadership team, especially in the domains of education and health.

Since its inception, SAS Foundation has focused on community-centric initiatives that create measurable impact and align with national priorities such as **Digital India**, **Swachh Bharat Abhiyan**, **Skill India**, and the **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs)**. The Foundation's programs are designed to empower the youth with knowledge, resources, and opportunities that enable lifelong self-sufficiency and civic contribution.

Objectives and Focus Areas

The SAS Foundation operates with the mission of empowering youth across four key focus areas:

1. **Education** – Providing value-integrated learning opportunities, reducing education deficits, and enhancing corporate grooming.
2. **Health** – Raising awareness on health issues and ensuring access to healthcare for vulnerable communities.
3. **Environment** – Promoting environmental sustainability through e-waste management, tree plantation drives, and other green initiatives.
4. **Community Development** – Engaging communities in inclusive initiatives for economic and social betterment.

The foundation follows a set of core values:

- **Doing real work with heart** to ensure tangible impacts.

- **Maintaining transparency** in operations to build trust.
- **Involving the community** in all initiatives for shared responsibility and participation.

Vision

To be a movement that acts as a catalyst in enabling and empowering youth towards employment and self-employment, reducing education deficits, and promoting corporate grooming in India.

Mission

- To bridge the gap for youth with no or limited access to corporate grooming and guidance towards employment and self-employment.
- To create a value-integrated learning environment that fosters strong entrepreneurial foundations and helps youth identify their potential.



As of **March 2025**, SAS Foundation has positively impacted **101,728 lives**, with significant milestones in:

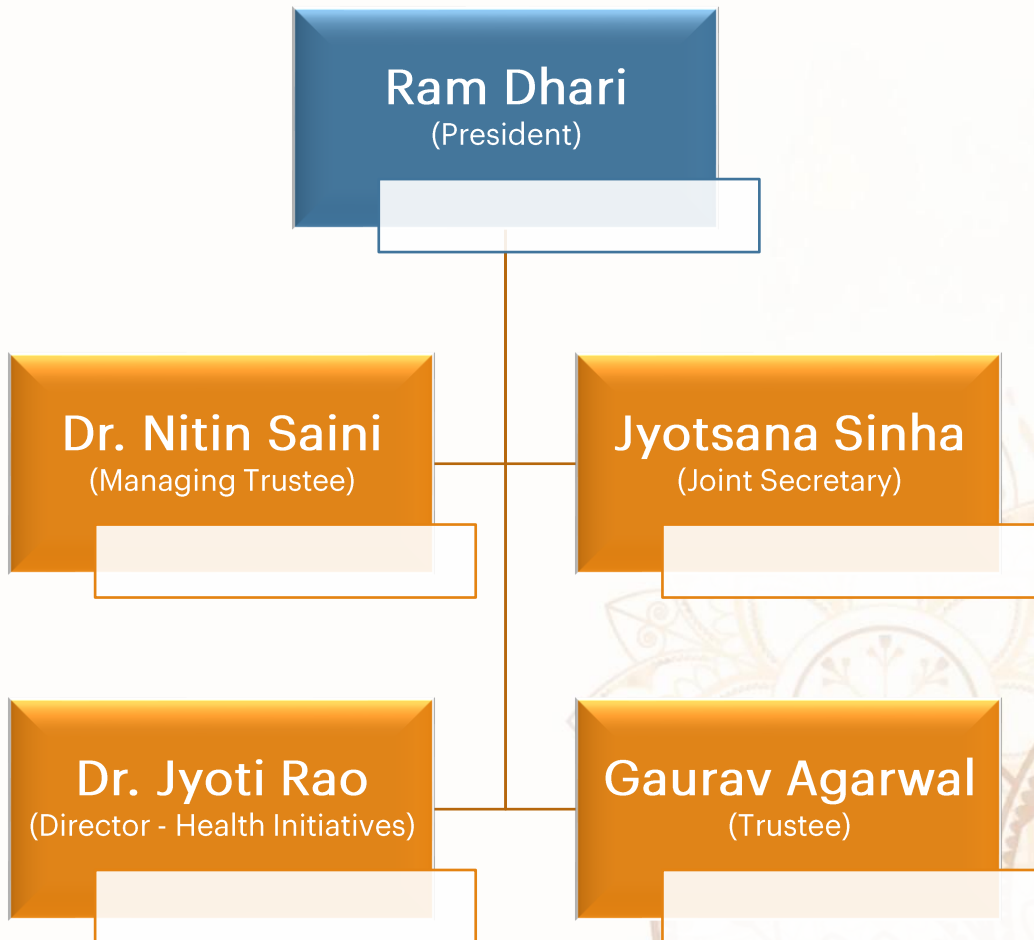
- **Education:** 6,870 lives impacted through awareness sessions, training programs, and digital literacy initiatives.

- **Community Development:** 15,855 individuals reached through community outreach, capacity building, and collaborative programs.
- **Health:** 585 lives supported through medical aid, awareness camps, and wellness initiatives.

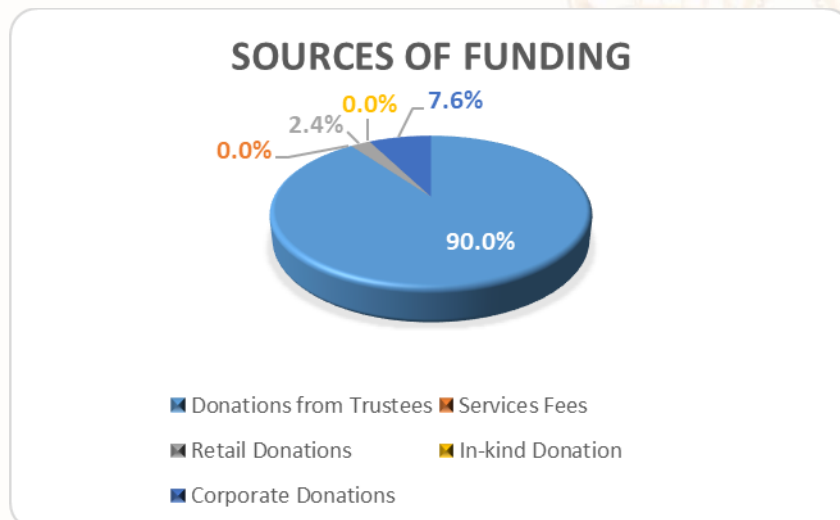

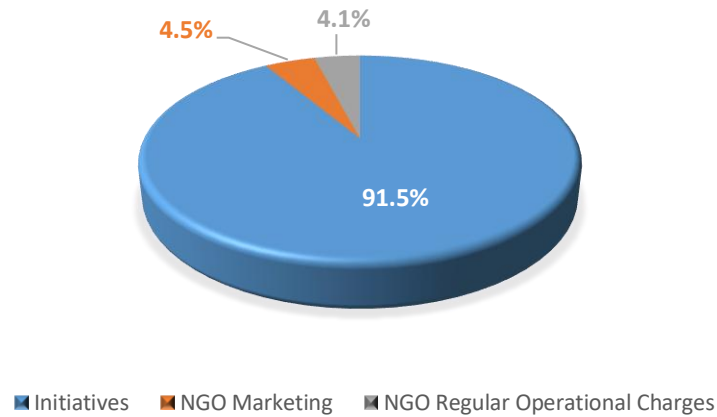

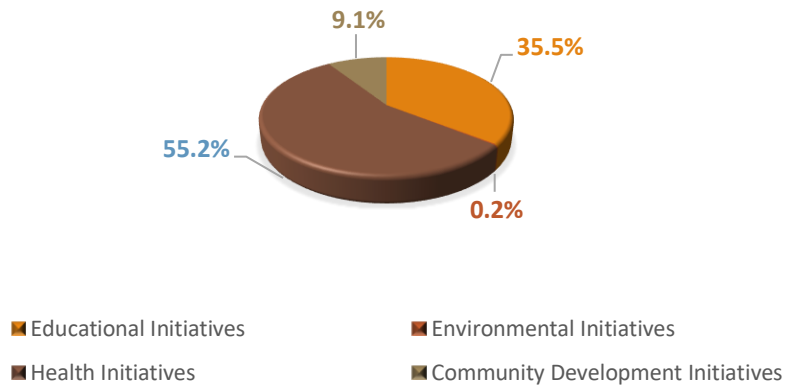

Global Impact

- Cervical cancer was the fourth leading cause of cancer and cancer deaths in women in 2022, with some 660,000 new cases and around 300,000 deaths worldwide.

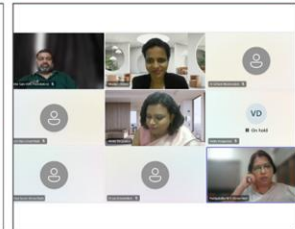
